Additionally, you will be expose to the different activities, like vigorous hiking , crossing creeks get familiar with medicinal plants that can help while in the bush. Furthermore most Mayan people in Toledo have experience walking under the high bush which give them a perfect knowledge how to live and eat directly from bush, however words are not enough to describe the **Gibnut Cave**.
