



Top Adventure “Davis Falls”



07:00 am from Punta Gorda Town (back 07:00 pm Punta Gorda)

This fantastic expedition will take you to the north-eastern tip of the Maya Mountains of central Belize. There is no beer, no nothing, except what you will carry on your back.

This is another world—a green, dripping, dark tapestry where rivers disappear underground. The rich vegetative cover of the Maya Mountains is ideal habitat for rainforest wildlife, from jaguars and toucans to Scarlet Macaw and Tapirs.

Davis Falls is the second largest waterfall in Belize with a drop of more than 500 feet to a large pool. It’s located some eight miles off the highway near Alta Vista Village (Stann Creek District). It is a vigorous fruit wagon ride over 7 river crossings.

Your guide will take you on a 1 1/2 hour hike through secondary growth rainforest and across crystal-clear streams to reach a most remote and beautiful spot where the falls crash down, divided in three fingers and crash down again. Enormous bromeliads, orchids, cohune palms, heliconias and tenacious lianas entangle their way through the verdant landscape and hundreds of birds species abound— from the keel-billed toucan to the purple-crowned fairy.

This is the only fall that you could go direct to fall and go right in the fall. Once there, you realize the fruits of your labor. These experiences will turn into memories to last a lifetime.
